Individual Awards	Medals awarded for Ladies, Gents and Juniors for Recurve, Compound, Barebow and Longbow subject to entries. Only double rounds shot will be eligible for medals and record status.								
Refreshments	There will be sausage and bacon sandwiches in the morning and tea, coffee and a selection of cakes will be available throughout the shoot.
